

Dress Standards August 1, 2020

*All dance wear should be clean and appropriate for the dance form you are participating in.
Dance on Broadway reserves the right to send a dancer home if dressed inappropriately for class.*

Ballet & Lyrical / Contemporary

3 year old Ballet / Ballet Tap Combo / Primary Ballet / Ballet 1

Pink or Black leotard, pink tights, sheer skirt may be worn. No Jewelry.

Ballet & Lyrical / Contemporary

Black, Blue or Purple leotard, pink tights (ballet) or beige tights (lyrical/contemporary) sheer skirt may be worn. Sports bra must match the leotard or be black.

12 and up: Pointe ribbons need to be attached to ballet shoes.

Ballet: Pink leather or canvas, full soled ballet shoes (no silk)

Leg warmers, ballet sweater/shrug, sheer skirt is allowed during bar work / warm up.

Lyrical / Contemporary: Foot undies

Hair: Ballet Bun

TIGHTS ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES

Tap / Jazz

Black, Blue or Purple leotard, pink tights (ballet) or beige tights (lyrical/contemporary) sheer skirt may be worn. Sports bra must match the leotard or be black.

Hair: Pulled back off the face or in a pony tail.

Fitted Jazz pant or dance short may be worn. Black Jazz Shoes / Black Tap Shoes

TIGHTS ARE REQUIRED UNLESS A JAZZ PANT IS WORN.

Clogging / Musical Theatre

Fitted jazz pants, legging or shorts, T-shirt. No pant should cover feet.

Clogging: Black clogging shoes Musical Theatre: Depends on type of dance, talk with instructor before purchasing.

Hair: Pulled back off the face or in a pony tail.

NO JEANS

Acro & Tumbling

Girls: Gymnastics leotard, dance leotard or bodysuit, dance shorts and footless tights

Clean bare feet or gymnastics shoes (not required)

Hair: Needs to be pulled back in a ponytail or braids and if really long in a bun or french braid. No Jewelry.

Boys: T shirt and shorts

Clean bare feet or gymnastics shoes (not required).

Hair: If long needs to be pulled back. No Jewelry.

At any time there is a wart, open cut/sore or injury on the foot in any form it needs to be covered with a bandaid, medical wrap or sock. A student may be dismissed until correct care has taken place.
